

# SIXTH THROUGH EIGHTH GRADE

WITH ONE-TO-ONE DEVICES, MIDDLE SCHOOLERS SEAMLESSLY INCORPORATE TECHNOLOGY INTO THEIR CURRICULA. EACH STUDENT USES A WIDE RANGE OF APPLICATIONS TO WRITE, COLLECT, ANALYZE, CREATE AND SYNTHESIZE INFORMATION. ACCELERATED MATH COURSES ARE OFFERED FOR QUALIFYING MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS. IN ADDITION, THERE IS AN EMPHASIS ON DEVELOPING YOUNG LEADERS AS THEY TRANSITION FROM CHILDHOOD TO YOUNG ADULTHOOD.





Students are partners in learning, empowered to become confident, disciplined, thoughtful, compassionate, faith-filled and creative young people. They are challenged to grow through an age-appropriate balance of intellectual, social, athletic and artistic opportunities to better understand themselves, to prepare for lifelong learning and to serve others.

## MATH

Math instruction in kindergarten through 7th grade uses the Illustrative Math Common Core aligned program that focuses on problem solving skills and building math thinkers. The middle school math program is ability based groups.





### LITERACY

Our literacy instruction is based on a balanced literacy philosophy to include skills, vocabulary, comprehension, grammar and writing. Teachers in our preschool 4-year old program through 2nd grade use the Wilson FUNdations program for phonemic awareness and phonics instruction, spelling and handwriting. Elementary and middle school teachers use Guided reading, book clubs and literature circles to teach fluency and comprehension skills. Our Leveled Book Room provides teachers access to teach from thousands of texts an authentic literacy experiences for all students.

# **MEETING THE NEEDS OF INDIVIDUAL LEARNERS**

Our Child First Team of learning specialists use several sources of assessment data to identify students who require additional academic support and intervention services. Students with diagnosed disabilities have the opportunity to attend Learning Lab in 5th through 8th grades for more intensive, individualized support.





We use a variety of sources for data collection to measure student growth throughout the school year, including i-Ready diagnostic assessments given three times per year. On average, our students score in the 80th percentile for both math and reading. Teachers use the data from assessments and classroom observation to differentiate instruction to ensure all students are challenged and assisted appropriately.



# HIGH SCHOOL PREP TEAM

Our team provides one-on-one support for students to find the right high school fit for them. We hold informational meetings and a high school fair where schools come to exhibit and speak with prospective families. In addition, our team prepares, supports and guides students and parents during the high school search and selection process to ensure their future success.

### **ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS**

Assists principal with curriculum, faculty supervision and professional development, high school articulation, the proactive facilitation and/or handling of any discipline issues, facilitates our Child First program, coordinates/ executes academic services and coordinates/facilitates student assessments. The Assistant Principals work closely with our faculty and families in creating the best possible learning environment for all students.

### DIRECTOR OF ENRICHMENT

Serves faculty and K-5th grade students with advanced curriculum, accelerated learning and grade level enrichment programs.

### **READING SPECIALIST**

Works with K-5 students providing explicit reading interventions. Assists faculty to better meet needs during these crucial literacy years.

### LEARNING SPECIALISTS TEAM

Two teachers assist K-8th students in need of additional support in math and reading through intervention and classroom push-in.

### **TECHNOLOGY COORDINATOR**

Dedicated to appropriately incorporating a balanced approach to technology into the school day. Includes management of the technology, facilitating new support of student and staff technology, and other technology related matters.

### **DIRECTOR OF ADMISSIONS & MARKETING**

Leads the Admissions Department and the High School Prep team. Highlights the school throughout the neighborhood and community.

### SCHOOL NURSE

Attends to the medical needs of students that arise during the school day. This role is filled by a full-time licensed nurse who is on-site during school hours.

### ATHLETIC DIRECTOR

Plans, coordinates and administers a comprehensive interscholastic athletic program for students in grades 1-8.



### SAINT CLEMENT SCHOOL & NOTRE DAME TRUSTEY FELLOWS COLLABORATION

Saint Clement school was accepted to the Trustey Fellows STEM Teaching Program at the University of Notre Dame. This is a fully-funded, three-year fellowship where a group of Saint Clement teachers collaborates with teaching teams from around the country as well as Notre Dame professors to learn cutting edge practices in STEM instruction. Through this process, Saint Clement has created a blueprint with a focus on increasing problem solving and critical thinking skills by weaving integrated STEM opportunities across all grade levels. Our hope is that students not only grow academically, but also in their faith by using STEM as a force for good to solve real-world problems.



# **STEAM CLASSES**

STEAM IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF OUR CULTURE AT SAINT CLEMENT SCHOOL. OUR STUDENTS, GRADES PREK - 8TH, VISIT STEM CLASS ONCE A WEEK FOR 40-MINUTES. TARGETED GRADE LEVELS COLLABORATE ON CONTENT AND OBJECTIVES BETWEEN CLASSROOM SCIENCE AND STEM CLASS TO EXTEND AND SUPPORT LEARNING.

STEAM CLASSES AT SAINT CLEMENT INCORPORATE REAL WORLD APPLICATIONS, REINFORCE CRITICAL THINKING, PROMOTE 21ST CENTURY SKILLS AND ENCOURAGE TEAMWORK.



# EARLY BIRDS

# **AFTER SCHOOL**

Led by our Director of After School Programming, the program is held each school day from 3-6 p.m. The After School Program is not intended to be a high-powered enrichment program. It is less structured than the regular school day and offers a variety of mixed age group activities, as well as quiet time for independent reading, games or homework. Outdoor play throughout the seasons, including games on the rooftop playground and in the gymnasium, is encouraged for all children. The program is supervised by part-time and full-time staff members who are committed to providing a fun, caring and safe setting.

# **ENRICHMENT COURSES**

Saint Clement School also offers a variety of enrichment courses during the after school hours. New courses are offered every trimester. A sampling of classes includes toice jessons, aoding alub, k ini k usicals, f oops, aooking, ahess and much more.

### **ADMISSIONS PROCESS**

Admission to Saint Clement School is dependent on respective class size numbers and a thorough review of the student's current academic file.

ALL NEW and TRANSFER students will be admitted on a probationary basis. A student new/transferring to Saint Clement is considered to be on both academic and behavior probation for up to one full school year.

ALL TRANSFER students entering will be evaluated and assessed to determine acceptance within Saint Clement School. Students applying to grade levels with a wait list will be placed on the wait list according to their appropriate grade level and application date submission.

# NEW STUDENTS IN PRE-K AND KINDERGARTEN

All accepted new PreK and Kindergarten students will come for a play date in May.

### QUALIFICATIONS FOR ADMISSION

An application for admission and a \$100 non-refundable application fee must be submitted to the school by January 15th for each student applying for admission. The following qualifications will be considered in determining priority for admission:

- 1. Families with a child currently enrolled at Saint Clement School.
- 2. Families who have been active, engaged, registered, and contributing parishioners and alumni of Saint Clement Church.
- 3. Families who are registered and engaged parishioners of neighboring Catholic churches.

### AGE REQUIREMENTS

**Pre-Kindergarten3:** The child must be 3 years of age by September 1st of the year they will begin school.

**Pre-Kindergarten4:** The child must be 4 years of age by September 1st of the year they will begin school.

*Kindergarten:* The child must be 5 years of age by September 1st of the year they will begin school.

### NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

Saint Clement is operated under the auspices of the Catholic Bishop of Chicago, a corporation sole, in the Archdiocese of Chicago. Saint Clement admits students of any race, color, gender, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students in this school. Saint Clement does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, gender, or national and ethnic origin in administration or educational policies, loan programs, athletic or other school-administered programs.

### **TRANSFER STUDENTS (K - 8)**

Once Saint Clement School has received the application and necessary attachments, it's reviewed for academic fit.

If it is deemed that there is a potential fit, the student will be asked to shadow at the school and interview with a faculty member.

The parents may be requires interview with the Administration.

Following these steps, an admissions decision will be made.

### **ADMISSIONS COFFEES**

Prospective families are welcome to register for an Admissions Coffee through our website, www.stclementschool.org. The Application For Admission is also available on the school website.

### **PRIORITY ADMISSIONS DATE**

To be considered for Priority Admissions, the *application for admission* and the non-refundable \$100 application fee must submitted by January 15th. Applications submitted after January 15th will be considered once the Priority Admissions Process is complete. In mid-February, emails of conditional acceptance or wait list status will be sent. Each applicant who met the January 15th Priority Admissions Deadline Requirements will receive an email at this time.

### ACCEPTANCE EXPECTATIONS

Parents are required to submit a non-refundable \$1,000 New Student Fee to hold your position within a week of receipt of the conditional acceptance letter.

A copy of the child's birth certificate, baptismal certificate (if applicable) and health records must also be submitted to the school at this time. The first tuition payment for the school year begins in the month of May, prior to the beginning of the academic year.
